Train and Bus Routes from Washington, DC

Directions to Johns Hopkins Bayview Campus NIDA/NIH 251 Bayview Blvd., Baltimore, MD 21224

According to MD Transit Authority, it takes approximately 1 hour to get to Baltimore on the MARC train and then approximately 30-40 minutes taking the busses to the Johns Hopkins Bayview Campus.

Traveling by MARC Train

From DC take the MARC train leaving <u>Union Station</u> on the <u>Penn Line</u> (into Baltimore). The MARC train costs \$7 each way.

When you get to Baltimore

Bus fare for Baltimore City is \$1.60 per trip, or \$3.50 for all day unlimited pass (all day pass is recommended).

<u>From the Penn Line</u> – Arrive at "West Baltimore MARC NB" stop.

<u>Take the #40 Bus (Erying & Eastern) Eastbound</u>: The #40 bus takes you to the corner of Bayview Blvd. and Bayview Commons on the Johns Hopkins Bayview Campus. When you get off the bus, walk on Bayview Blvd. in the opposite direction that the bus was traveling. We are located at the end of Bayview Blvd on the right side.

The NIDA building is the last one at the end of Bayview Blvd. up on a hill. The recruiting entrance (labeled Clinical Entrance on the map) is NOT at the front of the building. There is a blacktop walkway that goes around the left side of the building (from the main entrance) through large white rocks. Follow the walkway around the hill and around the side of the building. Come into the third glass door on the right-hand side (a parking lot will be on your left). Security will be there. Please let them know you have an appointment with Recruiting and they will direct you to the reception area. A map of the campus is enclosed for you as well.

MTA transit bus from the Baltimore Travel Plaza:

Take the #20 Bus from the Travel Plaza and O'Donnell St. to Ponca St. and Eastern Ave. At that intersection pick up the east bound #22 Bus: The #22 bus which will bring you on campus and drops you off on Nathan Shock Drive near the emergency room. Walk away from the emergency room (west) on Nathan Shock Drive. Turn right on Bayview Blvd. We are located at the end of Bayview Blvd on the right side.
